This is what you should do to deliver your homework:

- 1.) Open an HTML Editor of your choice: https://html-cleaner.com https://wordtohtml.net http://htmlg.com/html-editor (limited to 300 words in new browsers)
- 2.) Type and format the text in left window.

3.) Mark text in right window



4.) Copy marked text

5.) Paste text in Homework Window

6.) Paste text in simple Text Editor

- 9.) Open your text in any browser to read it independently of the HTML Editor



10.) To continue editing HTML code later, paste it in right window of HTML Editor and edit in left window.
